A gadget is something that makes life a little easier and more comfortable in camp. Lord Baden Powell said:

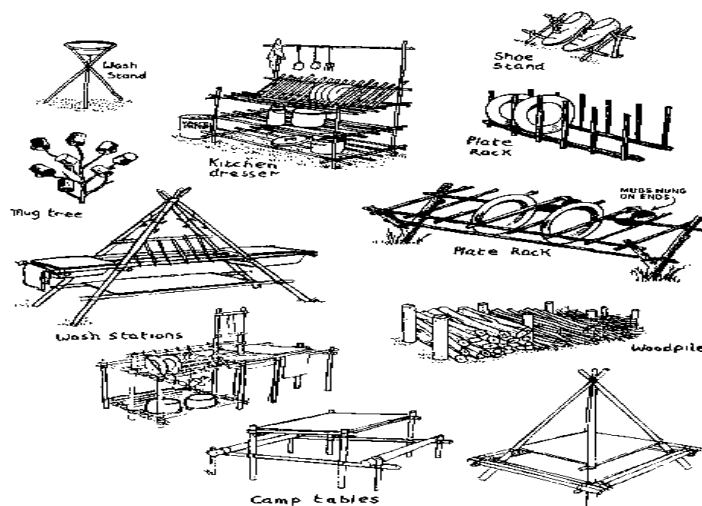
**A Guide does not rough it out in camp.**

## GADGETS - FURNITURE FOR YOUR CAMP HOME

That's what some gadgets are - furniture. Some gadgets are utensils. With wood, you can easily make almost anything from a roasting stick to a dining table. You don't have to be a carpenter. All you need is to know a few basic knots, hitches and lashings. And you need a dash of imagination. Once you know how to make a few gadgets, you can create your own for almost any purpose.

### NOTES:

1. Gadgets should be kept simple but strong.
  2. The thickness of cord used must be in proportion to the size of the wood used. Do not use string nor the new plastic or nylon cords as they will slip and knots will not hold. Heavy cotton cord is the best.
  3. Make sure that your gadget will stand (literally) when subjected to the little push test.
  4. Make your gadget on the first day and enjoy them for the rest of the camp.
  5. Make your gadget at the spot where it is going to stand.
1. Always dismantle gadgets at the end of the camp - twine and all - sad though it is!
