

## **PRESIDENT'S GUIDE AWARD 2026 APPLICATION FORM**

The President's Guide Award (PGA) is the highest accolade that a Guide can achieve. Hence, standards must be maintained. Guiders must ensure that the requirements are strictly complied with. The test clauses must be completed by the time the applicant is 17 years & 6 months of age. She must be a Girl Guide and not a Young Adult (YA).

Please note that candidates are limited to a maximum of two attempts at the PGA test.

### Qualifications of applicant

1. Obtained her Guides Gold Award and Baden-Powell Award.
2. Must be recommended by the Unit's Captain and School Principal.
3. Completed one of the following projects:
  - a) a self-initiated Values-In-Action project with a non-profit organization, *or*
  - b) a social action project, *or*
  - c) an advocacy project for a cause that the girl is passionate about (Guide is expected to plan and execute activities). Note that advocacy should be aligned with WAGGGS' requirements.
4. Attended a 3D2N overnight Guide camp. Sleeping under the canvas tent is optional but strongly recommended.
5. Holder of the following badges:
  - ✓ Pioneer Proficiency Badge
  - ✓ Homemaker Proficiency Badge
  - ✓ Friends to the World Proficiency Badge
  - ✓ Emergency Helper Proficiency Badge or First Aid Certificate
  - ✓ National Heritage Badge
  - ✓ 2 other Proficiency badges
