

GGG Gardens by the Bay Ambassador Programme



Learning Outcomes:

- Guides should be able to apply their knowledge of plants and sustainability efforts of the garden when they carry out the facilitation / garden guiding.
- Guides should be able to gain more confidence and experience as they play an active role in this award-winning garden.
- Every Guide to become a self-directed learner, confident individual, concerned citizen and an active contributor.

Guides need to complete sections A, B and C within 6 months from the starting date.

Section A

To attend an Orientation conducted by Gardens by the Bay. This session includes introduction to the Gardens, site visit and a training.

Depending on each Guide's choice, there may be an additional training session to attend.

Section B

To complete a write-up of at least 500 words on the importance of conservation.

Section C

To perform **ONE** of the following roles, from any of the two categories, at Gardens by the Bay:

1. Facilitation

- a) Facilitator : independent facilitation and delivery of entire programme content

OR

- b) Assistant Facilitator : partial delivery of content, together with other peers or in support of main facilitator

OR

2. Garden Guiding

- a) Garden Guide : to provide holistic garden guiding experience, with the knowledge of all key GB content areas

OR

- b) Station Guide : focus on assigned parts of GB content, or overview of generic GB content (less content heavy)

The attendance of the Guide for this programme will be monitored by staff of GGS and GB.
