1-Star Kayaking Proficiency Badge

In collaboration with X-Current of Exponent Challenge Technology Asia (ECTA)

Introduction

Girl Guides Singapore is collaborating with X-Current from Jan 2020 to provide more opportunities for Girl Guides to achieve the 1-Star Kayaking proficiency badge. This badge is achievable through the completion of the 1-Star Kayaking Award Certification Course.

It is preferable that girls have water confidence as they are required to complete Capsize and Rescue drills as part of their assessment.

Timing and Duration

- The 1-Star Kayaking Award Certification requires the girls to complete 2 days of courses.
- 100% attendance is compulsory
- There will be assessment of the skills during the course itself.

Guiders can choose between these two options

1. Over 2 days, 8am – 2pm
2. Over 2 weekdays, 1pm – 7pm

The duration between Day 1 and Day 2 should not be more than 14 days apart.

Venue

As of now, the kayaking courses will take place at

- Panda Reservoir, 11 Penjuru Road Singapore 609159.
The office is located at Level 1 of the Amenity Centre.

Course Fees

Number of Guides participating at one time: min. 8.

Cost charged: \$65 per head

This course is endorsed under the **Sports Education Programme (SEP)**. Respective Guiders should work with their school administration on to get further subsidy for the girls under the SEP.

As such, the vendor will liaise directly with Guider in-charge with regards to the invoicing and payment matters.

Process

- The more ideal dates for Kayaking are from Jan to April, June July to Sept and November.
- You are advised to book **at least 2 months** in advance to avoid disappointment
- Please propose at least two sets of dates.
- Cancellation fees apply when cancellation is less than 14 working days from the first day of the course date.

1. Sign up for the course via: [1-Star Kayaking Registration Link](#)
2. GGS will send the request for courses to X-Current.
3. X-Current will then liaise directly with Guider In-Charge.
4. Upon confirmation, X-Current will send the necessary details to Guider.

The indemnity form must be signed by parent/adult and brought onsite on the day of course.

Upon passing the course, X-Current will follow up with issuing the Certificates to the Guiders.

Guiders can then issue a badge certificate for the Guides to purchase the badge at the Guide Shop.

X-Current will issue the payment to the respective Unit through IFAAS.
