Invitation to Embark on Kindness Badge Junior

Greetings from the Singapore Kindness Movement (SKM)! We are pleased to invite you to embark on our Kindness Badge Junior (KBJ) programme in 2022.

The Kindness Badge is a mark of distinction awarded to students in Uniformed Groups (UGs) by SKM. It recognises their efforts at completing tasks that promote kindness and graciousness within their UGs, schools, families and the larger community. The KBJ programme is designed for primary school students in UGs and it identifies them as ambassadors of kindness.

There are two levels of the KBJ programme, of which the latter is optional:

- **Basic Level:** Students are required to complete tasks and initiatives using an activity booklet which will guide them through their Kindness Badge journey.
- **Advanced Level:** To attain an additional badge, students may proceed to this level which challenges them to research on community issues and propose ways to address these issues. More details can be found in the activity booklet provided.

Teachers-in-charge of UGs may register their students for the programme through the registration link found on the Kindness Badge website: <https://badge.kindness.sg/kindness-badge-junior/>

Upon registration, teachers will be notified about the collection of the activity booklets from their UG Headquarters (for Brownies and Cub Scouts) or from SKM (for the other UGs). After students have completed the programme, teachers will be required to share a few photos of the participants' works with SKM, before proceeding to collect the respective badges.

UGs may carry out the KBJ programme at their own pace. However, if they would like to receive the badges in 2022, the deadline for photo submission is **16 September 2022**. UGs that submit the photos after this date will attain the badges the following year.
