



## **Olave St Clair Award**

### **Overview**

The Olave St Clair Award is awarded to the girl member in her respective Pack/Company/Young Adult Branch, in recognition of her exemplary character and service that upholds the Promise and Law, impacting within and/or beyond Guiding activities.

This award is independent of the Chief Commissioner's Award Badge, Baden Powell Award, President Guide Award and other GGS Awards.

### **Implementation**

The deadline of the nomination of the award is aligned to the submission deadline for Puan Noor Aishah Award i.e.:

Deadline for Olave St. Clair Award (Brownie) – first Saturday of January

Deadline for Olave St. Clair Award (Guide) – last Saturday of January

Deadline for Olave St. Clair Award (Young Adult) – first Saturday of January

There can only be one awardee per Pack or Company in a year. There can only be one awardee per Peer Group in the Young Adults Branch in a year.

The nominee may be required to attend an Interview conducted by the Interview Panel consisting of the Brownie Branch Commissioner, Guide Branch Commissioner and Young Adults Branch Commissioner.

The results of the Award will be released by Term 1 Week 9 of the Ministry of Education School Calendar. The presentation of the Award for the Brownie/Guide is to be given at school level. The presentation of the Award for the Young Adult will be determined by the Young Adult Branch Council.
